
SYNOPSIS:

Across the Rails is the coming-of-age story of three young men in a backwater seaside town. It's 1972, not long after the 'summer of love' the Age of Aquarius maybe coming to an end but "freedom" is still the byword of existence. Chris, Liam, & Manny are floating aimlessly only peripherally aware that there is "more" out there. Equally lovable as they are inept, they decide to open a bar without any previous ability or concept of what it takes. Through the trials and tribulations of their journey, they come to discover who they are as individuals and what they really want in life.

DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

Originally from Liverpool, England, I spent my mid-twenties working as technical crew in the film industry in New York City. A serious rock-climbing accident found me returning to the UK for the first decade of the new millennium. Back in Liverpool, I directed a number of short films with help of Mersey TV, LA Productions and the UK Film Council. I had my first feature film script, The Holy Land, optioned by the award winning Ruby Films and had a successful, if somewhat brief, writing career for the BBC.

In 2010, I relocated to Delray Beach, Florida, which I now consider home. It's like Liverpool but with more palm trees. I set up the production company, Brave Man, nine years ago to help pay the rent and allow me to pursue my first love, filmmaking. Mark Ford, the executive producer, approached me about five years ago and said he had an idea for a movie based on the time he spent with two other friends in their early twenties when they opened a bar for young adults in Freeport, Long Island. I thought it had great potential, so myself, Mark and Steve Cabrera, his writing partner; work shopped the script for about 12 months until we were happy with the story. Across the Rails is a beautiful coming-of-age story set in 1972, about three young men who open up a bar in a working class seaside town in South Florida. I then collaborated with my childhood best friend, cinematographer Colin Watkinson, who recently won an Emmy for his work on Hulu's The Handmaid's Tale. Together we developed the visual style we would use to tell this story. Although both from Liverpool, we saw many parallels with the three protagonists – growing up in a working-class town where flying by the seat of your pants and thinking outside of the box was a way of life. I think ultimately, the story is universal. I hope you enjoy.



DRECTOR'S BIO

Damian brings twenty years of filmmaking experience to each and every one of the projects that he is involved with.

He wrote his first screenplay, The Holy Land, developed with Ruby Films and the UK Film Council in 2001. Damian has had several commissions from the BBC's Afternoon Plays Series.

Along with Brave Man Media, Damian has produced and directed spots for IT Advisors, Complyright, Remitly, & Absolut Vodka.

DIRECTOR OF PHOTOGRAPHY BIO


Colin Watkinson first knew he wanted to be a DP after going on location with the Peerless Camera Company in London. He worked his way through the camera department and became a professional DP in 2002. Colin drew critical acclaim for his remarkable work on Tarsem Singh's THE FALL, winning the Austin Film Critics Award in 2008 for Best Cinematography and garnering nominations for Best Cinematography at the 2008 Chicago Film Critics Association Awards and the 2008 Online Film Critics' Society Awards, as well as earning a spot on ASC's "top 50 films for cinematography of the last decade." Roger Ebert described it as "one of the most astonishing films I have ever seen."

In 2016, Colin lensed the award-winning series, THE HANDMAID'S TALE for Hulu and won the Primetime Emmy winner for Outstanding Cinematography. The series' haunting cinematography is the connective tissue that weaves its way throughout every character and plotline. In 2018 and 2019 the Hulu drama earned Colin's 2nd and 3rd nomination for Outstanding Cinematography. He also won the 2020 ASC award for the Episode 'Night' from Season 3. Colin was included in Variety's 2018 Artisan's elite report.

Colin is currently shooting 'The Power' for Amazon and Sister pictures with Reed Morano directing.

James Robert Wood started his acting career while at college, playing such roles as R.P.McMurphy in "One Flew Over The Cuckoo's Nest" and Stanley Kowalski from "A Streetcar Named Desire."


From there, he went on to perform in nearly 30 stage productions as well as starring in 10 short films.

An Eagle Scout, a Locksmith, a Libra, a Musician. Born and raised in Port Saint Lucie, Florida/USA.


UANCE ULASEK
